## Important Reminders

- ◆ **Students are required to make an appointment with their advisor well in advance of the beginning of registration each semester.**
- ◆ Admission to 3000-4000 level Sport Management courses requires:
  1. Adjusted GPA of 2.25.
  2. Completion of Area F with grades of C or better.
  3. Junior standing (60 hrs. or more credit).
- ◆ The College of Business Administration requires all students earning a Business Minor to complete ECON 2105 and ACCT 2030 prior to enrolling in any upper division Business Course (FINC, BUSA, MGNT, MKTG, etc.).
- ◆ You should take ECON 2105 and ACCT 2030 early in your program of study.
- ◆ Keep your personal information update on WINGS.
- ◆ You must earn a minimum of C in all courses in Area F and all major requirements including guided electives.
- ◆ Check your University Email account and Landrum P.O. Box **at least once a week.**
- ◆ One year prior to your anticipated graduation, contact your faculty advisor and make an appointment to clear for graduation.
